IT'S IN OUR HANDS

Why should members of our community participate in the 2010 Census?

Census data shapes the future of our community and defines our voice in Congress.

Census information helps determine locations for schools, roads, hospitals, child-care and senior citizen centers, and more.

Businesses use census data to locate supermarkets, shopping centers, new housing and other facilities.

Government officials use census data to allocate funding and grants to high-need areas and non-profit organizations.

Responses to the 2010 Census questionnaire are required by law. All responses are used for statistical purposes only, and all are strictly confidential - your personal identity is protected for 72 years after completing the census.

10 Questions, 10 Minutes. The 2010 Census is the shortest census ever distributed. It asks for name, gender, age, race, ethnicity, relationship, and whether you own or rent your home. It takes only about 10 minutes for the average household to complete.
